#### **5 Year Municipal Capital Works Plan**

The following are a list of items to make up the priority list for the Town's 5 year Municipal Capital Works Plan.

Items already approved and scheduled to be completed in 2020 include Paving and Road Reconstruction at Mint Cove Pond Road North, Lift Station Upgrade at Northern Cove adjacent the gazebo area and to install a backup generator system at the Town's Chlorination Plant. Further to this, we have applied to complete Paving and Road Reconstruction at Pondside Road and are awaiting approval for this project. Financing involved with these projects are already included in the 2020 Operating Budget.

### 5 Year Municipal Capital Works Program (2020-2024)

The following is a list of priorities recommended as a guide for Applying for Funding for Municipal Capital Works. Priorities are in order as listed.

1. **Pondside Road, Tilton** - Area to include from intersection at Back Track to the Basketball Court near the last hydrant

- 2. **Rectory Avenue-Casey's Lane, Annie's Lane** The area is commonly referred to as the loop.
- 3. **Cemetery Road, Tilton** Road leading to the graveyard at Tilton. This Road intersects with Back Track at both ends.
- 4. **Wastewater Treatment** This project may shift along the priority list depending on availability of provincial and/or federal funding. We are unable to provide an estimate at this time.

## **Gas Tax Eligible Projects**

The following is a list of projects recommended to be applied for under the Gas Tax Program. Priority order is as listed below. Please note that the year of completion is dependent on available gas tax funding for a particular year as it is not Council's intention to spend funding beyond the year eligible. (May take several years to complete dependent on cost)

- I. Costello's Road
- II. Blandford's Road
- III. Delaney's Crescent Phase 2
- IV. Chipman's Crescent
- V. **Jones Road** Plus extend approximately 150 feet beyond end of existing asphalt surface
- VI. Collins Lane Back Cove
- VII. Sheppard's Hill Up to Kennedy and across to Loveless
- VIII. Sheppard's Lane Near Baccalieu Trail Pharmacy
- IX. Meadow Road Near end of Valley Road
- X. **Smith's Road , Tilton** To include to end of existing pavement then beyond to last 2 houses.
- XI. Ryan's Road
- XII. **Anthony's Road** from end of existing pavement to the turn around at the top of the road.
